Ambassador-Designate to the Republic of Estonia

Ashish Sinha, a career diplomat, is an officer of Indian Foreign Service (IFS) of the 2005 Batch.

He arrived in Tallinn on 30 April, 2025 to take charge as the next Ambassador of India to the Republic of Estonia.

Prior to his current position, he was Joint Secretary (South), heading the Southern Division at the Ministry of External Affairs, responsible for bilateral relations with Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Vietnam, Malaysia, Philippines, Brunei, Cambodia, Lao PDR and Timor Leste. Prior to this, he was Joint Secretary (Summits) and Joint Secretary (G20) during India's G20 Presidency.

Mr. Sinha has served as a Deputy High Commissioner in Kenya, and in diplomatic capacities in Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations in New York, Embassies of India in Nepal and Spain. He also served in the Ministry as the Desk Officer for India's Relations with its neighbour Pakistan and in the office of External Affairs Minister.

He holds a Masters' degree in Management and a Bachelor's degree in Physics. He speaks Spanish in addition to English and Hindi.

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
